ALL animals whether for exhibit or sale must be vet checked (by independent vet or honorary vet) and display no visible genetic deformities.

Animal exhibits and / or sale of Alpacas and products.

Fleeces will remain on display for the remainder of the Show.

Exhibitors have the option to exhibit their animals on Friday and include animals in schedule at a reduced entry fee for those animals exhibited on the Friday. Those animals included in schedule are to remain on site until completion of animal judging on Saturday as determined by Convenor/Chief Steward

ALL animals must be vet checked (by independent vet or honorary vet) and display no visible genetic deformities.

**SPINNING FLEECE:** To be delivered to the Administration building and be clearly labelled with the exhibitor name, class and exhibitor number, by 8am Tuesday, 20 October 2015

**FLEECE:** Fleeces are to be delivered or have arrived (by post or courier) to the Administration building and clearly labelled with exhibitor name, and entry class, by 12 noon Thursday of Show Week. Fleeces will not be available for collection from the Alpaca Pavilion until 4pm Saturday, 24 October 2015

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

- 1) Exhibitors may not knowingly exhibit an Alpaca showing any signs or symptoms of a disease. Any Alpaca not deemed to be physically sound by the Royal Agricultural Show of Tasmania appointed inspector or a veterinary surgeon will be withdrawn.
- 2) All male Alpacas must be entire and deemed physically sound. Any Alpaca not deemed to be entire and physically sound by the Royal Agricultural Show of Tasmania appointed inspector or a veterinary surgeon will be withdrawn.
- 3) Marks of spaying in females will disqualify them from competing.
- 4) Any animal exhibit deemed by the Chief Steward in consultation with the appointed inspector or veterinary surgeon as unsuitable for display or judging will be withdrawn.
- 5) A wether may be a registered or unregistered Alpaca, exhibit no visible genetic faults and must be castrated.
- 6) Exhibitors must keep the stalls allotted to their animals clean and give proper attention to their stock throughout the show.
- 7) Stud names are permitted in animal stalls, but must be contained within the bounds of the pen and have a maximum height of 1500mm. "For Sale" signs are permitted only in nominated Exhibitor Sale Pens and must be removed by 5.00pm Friday. No For Sale signs are permitted on Saturday. A4 Folders attached to the front of an animal pen are permitted for promotional and sales material. However, no other advertisement or notices (except with the explicit permission of Chief Steward) are permitted on, or in, any stalls or buildings associated with the Alpaca Pavilion. Display of promotional alpacas will not be permitted on Saturday. Display of Show ribbons awarded at any previous Show are prohibited by the RAST on Friday and Saturday.
- 8) At the time of entry, all Alpacas entered, Display/Sale/Competition must be registered (except Wethers) with a recognised organisation, and at the time of penning must carry approved identification. The registered animals' number must be shown in the name of the registered owner or leasee and proof of ownership must be available if requested by Convenor or Chief Steward.
- 9) Companion Alpacas/animals will NOT be permitted unless prior approval has been given by the Convenor or Chief Steward on Saturday
- 10) All Alpacas will be inspected for genetic faults, colour, class, registration number and for infestation of lice, any animal found to have an infestation of lice will be removed from the Shed together with all other animals exhibited or entered by the owner at that time. Entries will be withdrawn from the Judging Catalogue and no refund of fees will be given.
- 11) The inspection of all Alpacas will commence at 8.00 a.m. on the Friday and 8.00 on the DAY of JUDGING.
- 12) Alpacas not in their allocated pens and available for inspection at the official time on Friday and Saturday may be disqualified by the Chief Steward. Exhibitors or his/her nominated representative, must be in attendance at the time of inspection.
- 13) Alpacas must carry a minimum fleece length of 50 mm for Huacaya and 75 mm for Suri. Huacayas, 12 months and over, must carry no more than 15 months fleece, and Suris, no more than 24 months fleece, at the time of showing.
- 14) Any decision on disqualification of an animal is entirely within the discretion of the Chief Steward, and such a decision may not be challenged or called into question in any proceedings or in any manner whatsoever.
- 15) An exhibitor may lodge a protest against another exhibitor or a Show official. However, the protest must be lodged in writing together with a deposit of \$50. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld or will be forfeited if the protest or complaint is considered frivolous. Such decisions will be decided by an appointed Disputes Committee.
- 16) Protests shall be lodged with the Chief Steward or Show Convenor within one hour of the alleged incident occurring.
- 17) Protests and all matters arising therefrom shall be adjudicated promptly and shall not be the subject of any appeal to any court or any order for review.
- 18) A Competitor may not discuss their Alpacas or a proposed exhibit with the judge on Friday or prior to, or during the show.
- 19) The Judge's decision is final, and he/she has the power to withhold prizes to any exhibit not deemed worthy of that prize.
- 20) **DRESS CODE: All attendants leading stock in the judging ring, or on parade, shall wear smart black long trousers, white dress shirt with collar, non patterned and no logos permitted. Shirts must be worn buttoned up. Closed in and sturdy shoes or boots so as to avoid any injury. No shorts, short dresses, or open shoes are permitted. This Dress Code applies to Junior Handlers and Junior Judges**
- 21) The Chief Steward may disqualify an exhibitor for incorrect attire.
- 22) All exhibitors shall, on the day of the Judging, obtain from the Shed Steward their pen position and class numbers. Class numbers of each exhibit must be worn and clearly displayed whilst in the Show Ring.
- 23) The animals must not be re-moved from their allotted pen whilst judging is in progress except by order of the Marshalling Stewards.

- 24) All Handlers showing animals must be competent in handling their exhibit, or removal from the ring may be requested by the Judge.
- 25) All fleeces are to be shown from Alpacas which are the bona fide property of the exhibitors. Only Fleeces shorn within the 18 calendar months prior to the judging date are eligible for entry.
- 26) Exhibitors when submitting fleeces at the Show must attach to the fleece the number supplied for that class (no names).
- 27) Wether Classes: At the discretion of the judge, classes may be split into colours.  
Fancy Classes: At the discretion of the judge, classes may be split into age groups
- 28) The Inspector or Chief Steward will classify all entries for colour and he/she has the power to transfer any exhibit to the correct class. The Chief Steward will combine or split classes as he/she sees fit.
- 29) The entrant shall enter each animal's registration details on the ENTRY FORM or online and attach or send a **COPY OF EACH ANIMAL'S REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE** to the entry form or to the RAST office. Indication to be given on entry form of the name of the Association of which the exhibit is registered. Tick box to be included for this purpose.
- 30) Animals are not to be removed during the show. A veterinary certificate explaining the absence of any animal must be provided.
- 31) In addition to any Special Regulations herein, all Exhibitors are subject to the General Regulations for Competitors and Exhibitors of The Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania. Copies of these rules are available on request from the Society.
- 32) Any disputes or contentious issues are to be brought to the attention of the Alpaca Show Convenor who will refer them to the RAST Council Steward for final adjudication.
- 33) Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania takes no responsibility for collection, receipt of any monies or loss of product as part of the Display / Sale Day. All transfers and associated costs remain the responsibility of the Seller. Animals sold on the day and entered into the Show Catalogue are to remain in the name of the entrant and all prizes awarded will thus reflect the name of the entrant.

<b>NON-ASSOCIATED MEMBER FLEECE SECTION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY</b>
---

- 1) Fleece/s entered must be the bona fide property of person/s who are not members of an Alpaca Association in Australia.
- 2) Fleece/s to be entered should be from an animal shorn within the last 12 months
- 3) Fleece/s should be a minimum of 50 mm in length for Huacaya and 75 mm for Suri.
- 4) Fleece/s are to be skirted, free from contamination and presented in a manner suitable for judging.
- 5) An Exhibitor must not discuss their exhibit with the Judge prior to or during the Judging
- 6) All Exhibitors are to abide by the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania Alpaca Section Exhibitors' Code of Conduct.
- 7) Any decision on disqualification of an entry is entirely within the discretion of the Chief Steward, and such a decision may not be challenged or called into question in any proceedings or in any manner whatsoever.
- 8) An Exhibitor may lodge a protest against another Exhibitor or a Show Official. However the protest must be lodged in writing together with a deposit of \$50. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld or will be forfeited if the protest or complaint is considered frivolous. Such decisions will be decided by an appointed Disputes Committee.
- 9) Protests shall be lodged with the Chief Steward or Show Convenor within 1 hour of the incident occurring.
- 10) Protests and all matters arising therefrom shall be adjudicated promptly and shall not be the subject of any appeal to any court or any order for review.
- 11) Any disputes or contentious issues are to be brought to the attention of the Alpaca Show Convenor who will refer them to the RAST Council Steward for final adjudication.
- 12) The Judges decision is final and he/she has the power to withhold prizes to any exhibit not deemed worthy of that prize.
- 13) In addition to any Special Regulations herein, all Exhibitors are subject to the General Regulations for Competitors and Exhibitors of the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania. Copies of these rules are available upon request from the Society.

## **ALPACA SECTION**

### **EXHIBITORS' CODE OF CONDUCT**

This Exhibitors' Code of Conduct is to be used in addition to the provisions in the RAST Showing Rules and Regulations to guide exhibitors in their responsibilities and behaviour.

This Exhibitors' Code of Conduct is effective during all stages of the RAST Show including, but not limited to: planning, preparation, coordination, set up, actual day of Show, and post Show clean up, dismantling and wrap up.

1. Participants shall not engage in the following activities or behaviours while attending RAST Shows
  - (a) Cruelty and mistreatment of Alpacas.
  - (b) Lack of compliance with RAST Rules and Regulations including attempts to circumvent rules and procedures.
  - (c) Falsification of information that is required by the show including but not limited to :  
entry information, disclosure statements, shearing dates, dates of birth, registration certificates, or ownership of alpacas.
  - (d) Negative, obstructive, or disruptive behaviour
  - (e) Abusive or foul language, rude gestures in public.
2. Participants should be courteous and gracious to judges, officials and fellow exhibitors at all times, regardless of class placements
3. Shows are public events, therefore, all show participants should at all times conduct themselves in a positive, professional and courteous manner. For those entering the ring, clothing should be neat and professional and be consistent with the dress code for the individual show. No identifying, advertising or promotional features, symbols, icons or badges are to be worn into the ring.
4. Show participants are assumed to know all Show rules and Regulations. Such individuals who voluntarily elect to participate in RAST Shows do so with the understanding that they are bound by these rules and are liable to incur disciplinary action for infringement of them.
5. Breaches in any of the above may result in a protest or report being filed by the Chief Steward, for breaches on the day of the Show, or by the Show Convenor, for breaches other than on the day of the Show, with the RAST for consideration of disciplinary action.
