Exhibits to be delivered via Main Gate. Howard Road entrance between the hours of 6.30am - 7.15am

Any vehicle remaining on the Showground after 8.00am will be towed away at the expense of the exhibitor. Cat Stewards will be on hand to accept exhibits and to ensure the cars are re-directed from the Showground. GROUP EVENTS:

Litter of Kittens - all living kittens from a single kittening.

CCC OF AWARDS:

This class is open to all cats registered with CCCA or ACF bodies only. Exhibits will automatically be entered in this class. No entry fee is necessary.

ULTIMATE AWARD OF MERIT:

This free class is open to all CCCT registered Grand Champions and Grand Premier Neuters. Classes will be for Male and Female, Entire and Desexed, in Groups 1, 2 and 3.

Financial members of the CCCT may apply for this certificate when they have won ten (10) awards.

COMPANION EXHIBITS

Domestic Pet Classes - all domestic exhibits must be desexed.

Domestic Pet Female Kitten Domestic Pet Male Kitten

Female/Male Desexed Pet - over 3 months and under 9 months on day of Show.

Unregistered Pure Bred cats are acceptable in this show in the section for Companion Cats. Exhibits MUST BE DESEXED. Registered Breeders are not eligible to enter this section.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Registration:

The Society may only accept entries for cats which are registered with a recognised Control body. Domestic Exhibits and Companion Cats are exempt from registration.

Entry Fees: All Entry Fees must be paid at the time of entry...

Veterinary examination:

A qualified Veterinary Surgeon shall examine each exhibit. He shall refuse to allow any cat to enter the exhibition if, in his opinion, it is suffering from any contagious or infectious disease or has external parasites, or which has been treated or prepared for exhibition in contravention of the rules and regulations of the Royal Hobart Show and the CCC(Inc). His decision in this regard shall be final. Should the Veterinary Surgeon reject one of an exhibitors exhibits for reasons of contagious or infectious disease or evidence of external parasites, all that exhibitors entries may be rejected at the discretion of the Veterinary Surgeon. No person may exhibit a cat which has been exposed to the risk of any infectious or contagious disease during the period dating at least I2 days prior to the exhibition. It is expected that all exhibits should have appropriate immunisations prior to the show.

Benching:

Curtains (coloured/white) are allowed during judging and, if required, a hot water bottle completely enclosed. Litter trays to be preferably plastic and rectangular in shape. No foodstuffs are allowed in cages before completion of judging. Cages must be kept clean by exhibitors. One small toy per cage is permissible.

Withdrawal of entries:

When a person withdraws a cat entered in the Royal Hobart Show, they shall be required at the time of withdrawal to furnish a written explanation to the Show Secretary, or persons running the show, which shall be forwarded to the CCC (INC). Where written explanation is not produced, or the RAST and/or the CCC (INC) considers the explanation to be unsatisfactory, the CCC (INC) may, at its discretion, request a Veterinary Certificate of clearance within 7 days, naming the withdrawn cat(s). Where a certificate is requested by the CCC (INC) and not produced within 7 days, the person(s) concerned shall be considered as being in enforced quarantine until such time as the certificate is produced.

Judging:

29.7 At the time of judging no person shall be allowed in the judging area save the judges and the properly appointed officials and stewards.

A judge's decision on the merit of the exhibit shall be final unless such decision is contrary to the rules and regulations of the RAST and the CCC (Inc). Judges are empowered and instructed not to award any prize, challenge or award of merit certificate to any exhibit which they consider is not of sufficient merit. Any cat which cannot be taken from its cage by the judge or steward will not be judged.

Owner's risk:

The RAST will be most anxious for the care and safety of cats sent for exhibition, or any other property entrusted to it, but it must be understood distinctly by exhibitors and all other persons, that the RAST will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any cat or property whether arising from accident, or other cause whatsoever, or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents servants or others

Junior Exhibitor of the Year: All exhibitors under 18 years of age are automatically eligible. Points awarded are – 5 for attending the show plus 1 for each exhibit entered.

Exhibits claws:

Exhibitors Please note the following CCC (INC) Rule

CCC (INC) Rule 28.4 All Exhibits must have *clipped claws*, clean ears and coats free from pests. Strict attention must be paid to this rule. Claws are not to be clipped within the show hall.
